Hallo RailML group,

the wiki says that begin/end should be used when "train part begins/ends at this ocp and is not part of a longer train path". I think this is confusing. Is it meant that the /train/ the train part belongs to begin/ends at this point? This is what I would expect - but the example file TT\_ICN.xml has begin/end for every train part and therefore, the information is quite redundant.

Also, what happens if the trainpart is used in some operational /and/ some commercial train, and while the operational one ends at some point, the commercial train continues to some other final destination?
