Dear community,
the standard currently does not allow <blockPart>s with referenced <trainPart>s with any <mission> other than timetable. This means that these <blockPart>s cannot have track information (as there is no <ocpTT>, only <startOcp> and <endOcp>), nor can the fact that they come coupled with other <blockPart>s be exported in railML.

Is there any best practice to circumvent that problem? We consider using an <other:myShuntingMissionType> and referencing <trainPart>s, and using the <trainPart> category to identify non-trains (that is, shunting trips etc.)
