- They refer to version 2.0. As there is the rule "no major changes in minor version" in railML, they cannot be outdated since there is no version 3 so far.

- In [1] (Train coupling and sharing), the information is very general and I do not see how or when it will be outdated at all. There may be changes necessary in when there will be railML <timetable> 3 version, but so far, there is none.

- In [2] (Reversing trains and formations), I do not see which attribute or element of railML 2.3 has outdated this information. I am not sure in this point, so dear Ferri Leberl, please tell me which attribute justifies this "outdated" in your opinion.
