Dear Dirk,

> I do only prefer railML.org to formally ensure that the enumeration values for the attribute "register=" can only be set to registers which are clearly intended to be used at exactly this occurrence of "register", namely at <ocp>s, not for that at <line>s.

Why do you want to have this clear separation?

Will it help to rename the attribute <ocp>@register into

<ocp>@ocpRegister? This may be useful in future if we extend the designator concept to lines, too, having an attribute

<line>@lineRegister? Both attributes may point to registers listed in the codelist Registers.xml.

Would this work for you?
