- 1) One overview would be useful as most UC will be not limited to one subschema, e.g. IL will always need basic IS description.
- 2) The new table shows a problem of (duplicate) changes at different places. The list of IL-UC in this table does not match the IL-specific list.
- 3) I would prefer the consolidated list as the only one. "Filtering" can be done by the sorting of columns.
