Hello Christian,

we have another question about the representation of the <information Areas>. We use the <tGeoCoord> elements to define their dimensions. These also contain information about the height of an item. However, in the context of the <informationArea> this is irrelevant and could possibly lead to confusion. In our view, it would be a clearer modelling if we used geo-coordinates that do not contain height information. Since we do not necessarily want to introduce a new element for this, our question is whether such an element already exists. Alternatively, we would use the existing <tGeoCoord> element and point out in the documentation that in this context the height should not be specified.
