Hi,

the route destination is define by its routeExit element. This can have [0..*] overlap child elements. Thus it is possible to define several overlaps for one route.

The flank protection can be explicately defined only by references from the route to routeReleation elements. However, if you want to define different flank protections for different overlaps, there is no mean to differentiate the relation to any particular overlap. In that case it would be the best to define a route for each overlap.
