Going through the schema I noticed that it's possible to specify multiple "times" records for an ocp of a trainpart. I imagine this is being used to specify operational times and times published to the customer/traveler for each stop. I assume these records, if provided, can be differentiated by the provided scope values.

Since scope is specified to be a string value my question would be, from your experience, which values are most commonly being used for which class of stop times.
